In previous years we have had a range of large scale lanterns, from a giant Eagle representing Barclays Bank, to large scale Police lantern made by local officers, to a giant slipper promoting the annual Pantomime shows at the New Victoria Theatre.

Workshop details

- Time:** The workshop will start at 9.00am, with refreshments being served from 8.45am. We will aim to finish by 4pm.
We suggest you bring a packed lunch with you as it will be a full day's work!
- Venue:** Bishop David Brown School, Albert Drive, Woking, GU21 5RF
- Other information:** We suggest you have a team of 2 or 3 people to make your masterpiece and wear casual clothes.

The workshop will be led by a professional artists who will guide you through the process of making your large scale lantern along with tips and advice about decorating to make it truly unique!

Please note that by attending the workshop, you are committing to attending and carrying your lantern in the Diwali parade on Friday 23 October in Woking Park. On this day, you will need to meet in the Leisure Centre at 5.15pm for a short safety briefing and lighting of your lantern for the commencement of the parade at 6pm.
